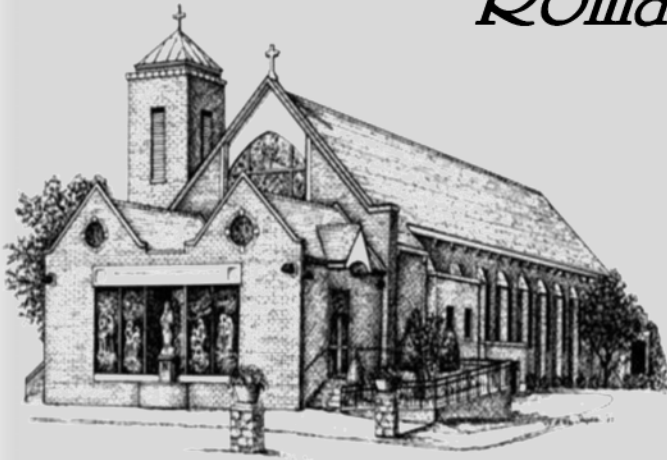

H.O.P.E. (HELPING OTHER PEOPLE EAT) (ASSISTS MISSIONARIES OF GOD)

EACH THURSDAY we collect and deliver food to a location in Dover that feeds 30-100 souls, depending on the time of year. We ask parish volunteers to make a tray or family size portion of the entrée of the day, while others who are not able to cook to contribute can box goods for us to supplement the meal. Items do not have to be made at home, rotisserie chicken, and other entree from the grocery store work too. Also we accept any style ie: sausages – plain, peppers a/o onions, sauerkraut, stuffing, etc. The food should be cooked but does not have to be warm if made the night before or earlier in the day (chicken nuggets and hot dogs may come in uncooked.) Drop off Thursdays by 1pm at school cafeteria side door.

Sep 8: Ham
Sep 15: Salads

Sep 22: Chicken Parm
Sep 29: Pork Chops

Items needed for pantry: fresh, frozen or canned vegetables (peas, carrots, corn, green beans, spinach, beets, mixed, broccoli); fresh or canned fruit (apples, oranges, peaches, pears, pineapple, applesauce, fruit cocktail); cookies; Parmalat; instant: rice, mashed potatoes, stove top. These items may be dropped off at the school any day, side cafeteria door or in the narthex labeled HOPE (so they do not get sent to the other pantries). We also accept grocery store gift cards.
