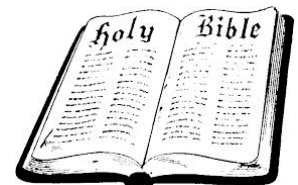

## H.O.P.E. (HELPING OTHER PEOPLE EAT) (ASSISTS MISSIONARIES OF GOD)

**EACH THURSDAY WE COLLECT** and deliver food to a location in Dover that feeds 30-100 souls, depending on the time of year. We ask parish volunteers to make a tray or family size portion of the entrée of the day, while others who are not able to cook to contribute can/box goods for us to supplement the meal. Items do not have to be made at home, rotisserie chicken, and other entree from the grocery store work too. Also we accept any style ie: sausages – plain, peppers a/o onions, sauerkraut, stuffing, etc. The food should be cooked but does not have to be warm if made the night before or earlier in the day (chicken nuggets and hot dogs may come in uncooked.) Drop off Thursdays by 1pm at school cafeteria side door.
