As you hear Paul's advice about work, what strikes you in the reading? What single word stands out to you?

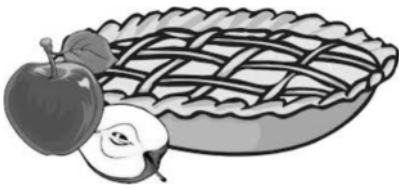
QUESTION FOR CHILDREN: Jesus teaches us that work is good for us. What kind of work do you do during the week? How does it help you?

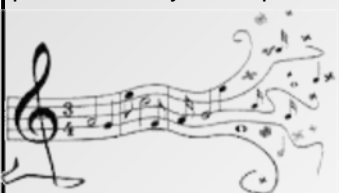
MORE BEAUTIFUL SONGS FROM FR. DAVID!

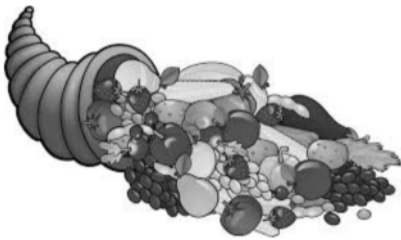
