Suggested text for faith sharing:
Today's 1st Reading from Isaiah
First Sunday in Advent

WEEK OF NOVEMBER 27, 2016

THEME: Waiting, hoping, and preparing.

STEP ONE: LISTEN TO THE WORD

As you hear this reading, what words or phrases strike you? What in this reading touches your heart? What image from Isaiah lingers in your memory?

QUESTION FOR CHILDREN: What can you do to be ready for God to come into your heart and your life?

QUESTION FOR YOUTH: The Gospel tells us we don't know when the Son of Man will return. If he were to arrive today, would you be ready for him? What is one thing you can do during Advent to prepare for his coming?

QUESTION FOR ADULTS: As you prepare to re-welcome Christ into your heart while you prepare for Christmas, what does Isaiah call you to do? What does Isaiah call us as a people to do?

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS-RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is meant for those who:

- have never been baptized but are curious about Christ and all He taught:



- have been baptized in other Christian traditions, but have an interest in Catholics and the Catholic Church:

- are already baptized Catholic but have never received Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

We are accepting enrollment for the 2016-17 session.

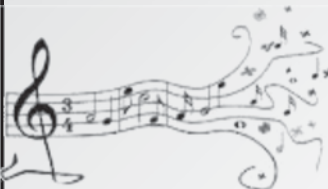
MORE BEAUTIFUL SONGS FROM FR. DAVID!
