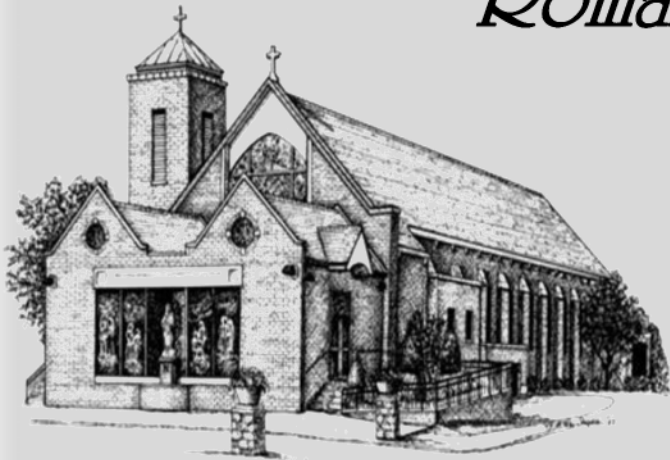

FAITH & FAMILY FORMATION

~BREAKING OPEN THE WORD~

Suggested text for faith sharing: Today's Gospel
Second Sunday in Lent

WEEK OF MARCH 12, 2017

THEME: Transfiguration - with the Spirit of Jesus living within us, we will be transformed.

STEP ONE: LISTEN TO THE WORD

As you heard the story of the Transfiguration proclaimed today, what particular words did you notice? What line in this reading touched your heart?

QUESTION FOR CHILDREN: Share about a time when you felt especially close to God or Jesus.

QUESTION FOR YOUTH: Have you ever had a "mountain top" experience where you felt exceptionally close to God? How was your life changed by that experience?

QUESTION FOR ADULTS: Perhaps this reading calls us, not to cling to the familiar, but to leave the comforts of the parish and reach out to the world around us. In your neighborhood or community, who is waiting to hear the Good News?

Bishop Serratelli has granted a dispensation from the laws of fast and abstinence to all Roman Catholics living in or visiting Diocese of Paterson on Friday, March 17, St. Patrick's Day.

"This dispensation is given with the strong recommendation that the faithful honor both St. Patrick and this holy season of Lent by some special work of charity or exercise of piety in place of abstinence,"from Bishop Serratelli.
