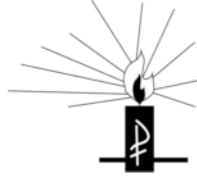

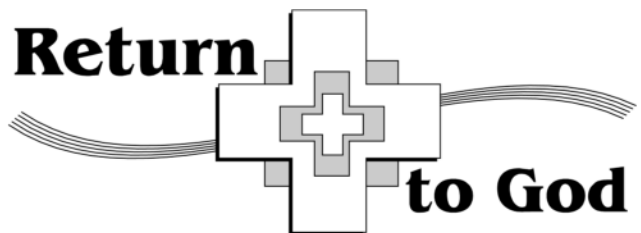

THEME: We are children of the Light.

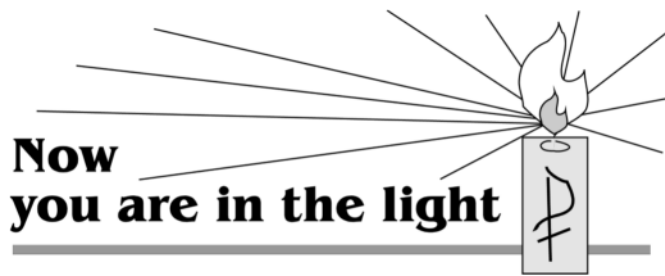
STEP ONE: LISTEN TO THE WORD
