This devotion stems from the revelations of Jesus to a young Polish nun early in the 20th century, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska. In the words of Fr. George Kosicki, CSB, of Divine Mercy International: "Two words sum up the message- trust and mercy. God is mercy itself, and He pleads with us to turn to that mercy and receive it. That's His Part. Our part is to receive it mainly by trust - abandonment to Him".
