WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 11, 2016

THEME: Come home. God's forgiveness is always there. God forgives before we even ask for forgiveness.

STEP ONE: LISTEN TO THE WORD

You have heard this parable many times. When you listened to it today, what word or phrase or image really struck you? What feeling does this story leave you with?

QUESTION FOR CHILDREN: The father in this story welcomed his son home, even after he ran away and did bad things. How do you know God welcomes you after you do that?

QUESTION FOR YOUTH: The prodigal son was welcomed home even though he had sinned. How hard is it for you to ask for forgiveness? Is it hard for you to believe that you are still loved even when you have sinned?

QUESTION FOR ADULTS: When you wander away from being true to your faith, how do you know God will take you back? What signs do you see?

H.O.P.E. (HELPING OTHER PEOPLE EAT) (ASSISTS MISSIONARIES OF GOD)

EACH THURSDAY WE COLLECT and deliver food to a location in Dover that feeds 30-100 souls, depending on the time of year. We ask parish volunteers to make a tray or family size portion of the entrée of the day, while others who are not able to cook to contribute can/box goods for us to supplement the meal. Items do not have to be made at home, rotisserie chicken, and other entree from the grocery store work too. Also we accept any style ie: sausages – plain, peppers a/o onions, sauerkraut, stuffing, etc. The food should be cooked but does not have to be warm if made the night before or earlier in the day (chicken nuggets and hot dogs may come in uncooked.) Drop off Thursdays by 1pm at school cafeteria side door.

These items may be dropped off at the school any day, side cafeteria door or in the narthex labeled HOPE (so they do not get sent to the other pantries).

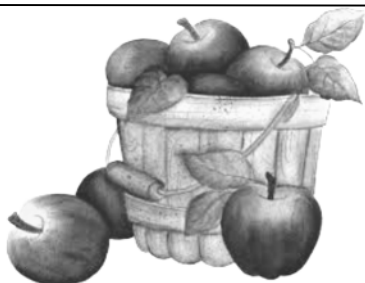
