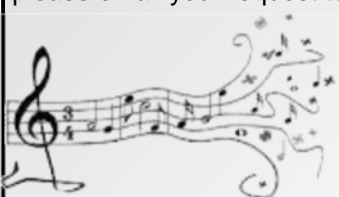
## MORE BEAUTIFUL SONGS FROM FR. DAVID!

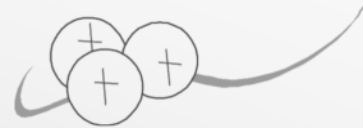
