Suggested text for faith sharing: Today's Gospel
Solemnity of Christ the King
WEEK OF NOVEMBER 20, 2016

THEME: In Christ, everything continues in being.

STEP ONE: LISTEN TO THE WORD

As you hear this familiar story of Jesus on the cross, what words or phrases catch your attention? In this reading, what touches your heart? What image strikes you?

QUESTION FOR CHILDREN: : Jesus is always kind to those who love him. How do you show your love for Jesus?

QUESTION FOR YOUTH: This week we celebrate Christ the King. In the best sense of the word, a King is some one who cares for the people under his care, and also has authority over them. When have you felt Jesus' care for you? How do you allow Jesus to have authority over you?

QUESTION FOR ADULTS: As you think about Jesus on the cross, having compassion on the "good thief," what lesson do you draw from it for your own life?

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS-RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is meant for those who:

- have never been baptized but are curious about Christ and all He taught:



- have been baptized in other Christian traditions, but have an interest in Catholics and the Catholic Church:

- are already baptized Catholic but have never received Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

These are the people the Rite of Christian Initiation seeks to reach and to serve.

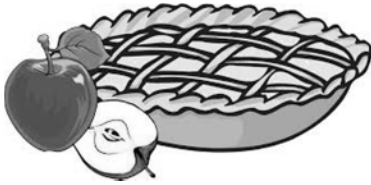
We are accepting enrollment for the 2016-17 session.
