THEME: God's kingdom is close - it is Jesus.

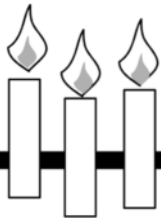
STEP ONE: LISTEN TO THE WORD

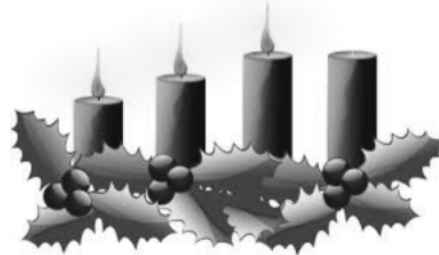

NEW JERSEY'S ADOPTION LAWS HAVE CHANGED!!

BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2017, adoptees and certain relatives will be able to obtain a copy of their original birth certificate without a court order. The birth certificate will include the names of the birth parents who placed children for adoption unless a birth parent requests their name be omitted.

Birth parents who wish to preserve their privacy must submit a **Redaction Request Form** to the New Jersey Department of Health no later than **December 31, 2016.** The **Redaction Request Form** can be obtained by calling 866-649-8726, ext. 582 or downloading it at <http://nj.gov/health/forms/reg-36c.pdf>.

The Catholic Church has always supported reunions between adoptees and birth parents, if such reunions are by mutual consent. The Church continues to do so through their Catholic Charities agencies.
