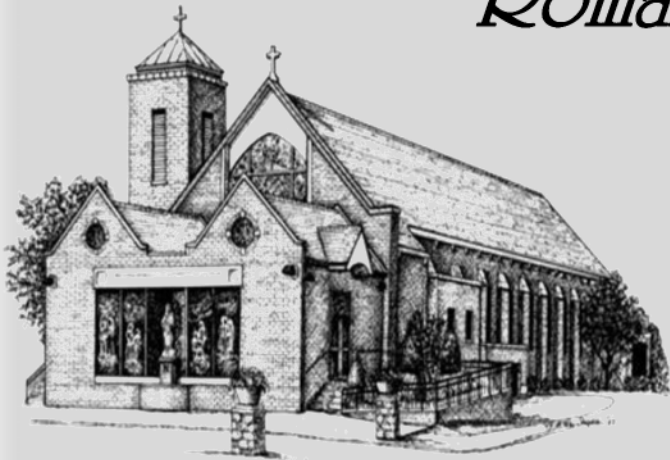

WEEK OF MARCH 19, 2017

THEME: Jesus is the Living Water
