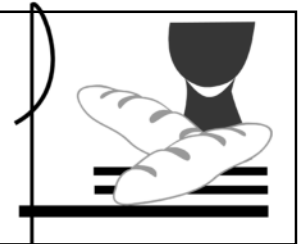

*June 3, 2017 will mark the 200<sup>th</sup> birthday of Blessed Pauline von Mallinckrodt (Mother Pauline), founder of the Sisters of Christian Charity. In an effort to make Mother Pauline better known, we begin a series of biographical sketches.*

Pauline von Mallinckrodt was born on June 3, 1817, in Minden, Germany, the first of four children of Detmar von Mallinckrodt, a Protestant, and Bernardine von Hartmann, a Catholic. According to the prevailing law of Prussia, Pauline should have been raised in the religion of her father; but, risking his government career, Detmar permitted his daughter to be baptized, raised, and educated as a Catholic. This was not without difficulty in a household with a high public profile, where matters of state and religion would naturally surface from time to time; but Pauline's mother was careful to see that love overcame all controversy.
