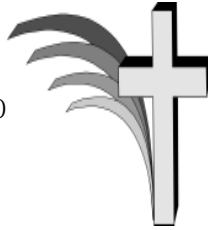

It is a process for the Unbaptized, Baptized Christians from other denominations and for Baptized Catholics who wish to complete the Sacraments of Initiation: Eucharist and/or Confirmation.
